Master of Education Micro-credential Course

Our newest micro-credential offers kaiako the opportunity to expand their knowledge of modern teaching approaches, such as culturally responsive teaching; inclusive learning; and the role of technology, including AI, in the classroom. The course will assist kaiako in implementing strategies that provide akonga with educational experiences that are engaging and meaningful, reflecting real-life contexts.

Course modules:

- ◆ The Teenage Brain: Identity formation and relationships
- ◆ Establishing Conditions for Autonomy: Fostering student agency
- ◆ Building Mastery: Working within students' "Goldilocks Zone"
- ◆ Connecting Purpose: Secondary context and the "Real World"
- ◆ The Tech World: AI in the classroom

Topics covered include:

- ◆ Gender, cultural and neuro-divergent identity
- ◆ Trauma informed approaches
- ◆ UDL and class differentiation
- ◆ Effective pre-assessment
- ◆ Restorative practices
- ◆ Collaborative learning
- ◆ Metacognition
- ◆ Complex thinking
- ◆ Connected curriculum

The course will be taught over a school term, through self-paced modules, webinars and a one-day face-to-face workshop.
